School Immunisation Program - COVID Vaccination Information

Moreton Bay Regional Council will visit Caboolture State High School on **Friday 22nd October 2021** to provide Gardasil (Human Papillomavirus) and Boostrix (Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis) vaccines for year 7 students. These vaccines will only be provided to students with a completed School Immunisation Program consent form signed by the parent or guardian.

As a minimum 7-day interval is advised between administration of a COVID-19 vaccine and any other vaccine, including influenza vaccine, Moreton Bay Regional Council is seeking your assistance to identify any students who will no longer be eligible to receive their scheduled vaccinations at the school clinic on 22 October 2021.

If your child has had a COVID vaccine in the last 7 days or has an upcoming appointment please advise Moreton Bay Regional Council by email to immunisation@moretonbay.qld.gov.au including the following information:

- Child's name
- Date of birth
- Date of COVID vaccination; or
- Date of appointment for COVID vaccination

If your child is no longer eligible to receive the School Immunisation Program vaccines at school, you will be notified by email of alternative arrangements to receive the missed vaccine/s.
