Instructions for students

No Year 12 classes will be on during the block. Students are **not** required to attend **unless they have an exam or VET catch up**.

All students are required to be in full school uniform.

A supervised study room is available in the library for students wishing to work on other assessment items, please sign in with the supervising teacher on arrival.

All students at school are to be in either: an exam, VET catch up or study room during usual class times or sign out of the school.

Students in the morning session will be signed into the school at their exam or VET Catch-up session. Students arriving for the afternoon session must sign in via the office except as stated below.

Exam Instructions

Students should arrive at exam venues **15 minutes prior** to the commencement of exams.

- Students arriving for the afternoon session will be required to sign in via the office.
- Students who miss an exam will need to complete an AARA to have an opportunity to sit it at a later date, AARAs can be accessed via the school website and are emailed to the Year level deputy and Mrs Caton.
- Students involved in traineeships are to notify their trainers if they have an exam on the same day.
- Unless otherwise indicated, all exams are in the Assembly Hall.
- All equipment is to be in a clear pencil case or plastic bag.
- Only clear drink bottles with water are permitted.
- No mobile phones, ear phones or smart watches are permitted in the exam venue.
- Check the seating plan on the court side of the hall to find your seat prior to entering the hall.
