ROLE DESCRIPTION

Students should carefully read the following role description, which describes the functions of a Student Leaders.

1. To model the PRIDE values of the school by being an active and positive role model.
2. To uphold Caboolture State High School's Responsible Behaviour Plan for Students, which encompasses adherence to uniform and behaviour expectations.
3. To represent the school at appropriate events, including school and community based events.
4. To host official visitors to the school.
5. To speak as a representative of Caboolture State High School on official and informal occasions.
6. To perform responsibly in the academic, sporting and cultural activities of the school.
7. To be sensitive to the needs and opinions of the student body and to develop a rapport with students of all levels.
8. To work in a co-operative manner with staff of Caboolture State High School.
9. To display initiative as a leader for the benefit of students, the school and the community and where necessary, organise and direct students. Support the leadership demonstrated by all students.

You are to address the selection criteria attached on the next page. You will be required to deliver a speech to the cohort outlining what you will be able to bring to the role of as a leader.
