The Arts Enrichment Program is specifically designed for students from Year 7-12 who have a genuine interest and demonstrated ability in either music or drama.

The program offers students the ability to work alongside like-minded performers throughout a range of workshops, incursions and performance opportunities. Students who enjoy being challenged, and those who strive to improve their musicianship and songwriting, or acting and devising skills, are encouraged to join the program.

Guided by industry professionals, a diverse range of music and drama workshops will help students refine their performance skills, both individually and collaboratively. In music, students will strengthen their stage presence and learn techniques to engage a live audience, whilst gaining valuable insight into key aspects of the music industry. They will enhance their composition skills and gain confidence using Digital Audio Workstations (DAWs) to create and record original pieces. In drama, students will strengthen their improvisation, voice, and movement skills through ensemble collaboration, in activities such as play building, scripted performance, and Theatre Sports.

Students will have the opportunity to participate in music or drama excursions that inspire creativity.
