

Students undertaking courses at the Trade Training Centre gain skills using a range of tools and equipment whilst undertaking learning tasks. Some equipment has inherent high risk levels such as the Metal Bandsaw, Cold Saw, Drill Press, Mill Drill, Metal Lathe, Milling Machine, MIG Welder, Electric Arc Welder, Coxy Acetylene Welding, Plasma Cutter, Angle Grinder, Circular Saw, Metal Cut-Off Saw, Jigsaw and Automotive Hoist. Parents are advised that the Department of Education does not have Personal Accident Insurance coverage for students. Education Queensland has public liability coverage for all approved school activities and proved compensation for students only when the Department is negligent. If this is not the case, then all costs associated with injury are the responsibility of the parent/caregiver. It is a personal decision for parents as to the type and level of private insurance cover for their student (if desired). Courses are funded by the Department of Trade, Employment & Training. Students are eligible to complete one VETIS funded course. For more information speak with the VET Coordinator at your school.
