COURSE CONTENT

Students in Year 7 will study two Arts subjects over a semester. The possible Arts subjects are Drama, Music, Music Extension, and Visual Art. All of these subjects are fun, interactive, and engaging allowing students to be creative and expressive through the Making and Responding dimensions. Participation in The Arts can have the potential to help improve a student’s memory and concentration skills, develop decision-making and critical thinking skills, enhance communication and listening skills, and encourage focus and discipline.
